Differences in technical and tactical preparation of futsal and football

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ABSTRACT:

The aim of this thesis was to map the differences in technical-tactical preparation of the futsal and football. The bachelor thesis is divided into two main parts, on the theoretical part and on the part of the practical. The theoretical part focuses on the general things of football and futsal, concerning their history, creation and diversity in the training. Also it is described here the divergence of the two sports and in both technical and in terms of tactical. The practical part consists of a questionnaire survey and from the individual in-depth interview. The questionnaire survey whether the performance of the player and the quality of the competition, which it operates, affecting the technical and tactical maturity. During the individual in-depth interview, which was conducted with the professional football player and the occasional futsal player, the interviewee answered the 20 questions, which were of a similar nature as questions for other respondents from the survey. The aim was to find out whether a professional football player and occasional futsal player has similar technical and tactical habits as the other respondents, who do not feature as professional athletes. The output of the practical part will be processing results and their evaluation in well arranged graphs.
