## Abstract

The subject of this symbolism in Korean martial art Taekwondo is the analysis of symbols appearing in the two largest Taekwondo Federations - ITF and WTF.

Thefirst part introduces relevants emiotic theories, historical background, the emergence of tackword o and its federations and a short biography of Ch'oe Hongh \( \tilde{u} \) - one of the most important figures associated with this martial art.

Theextensive second part presents a closerlook on symbolism, language and visualsigns and theirdevelopment in the most commonstyles: ITF and WTF. Fromthelanguagesigns, due to theiramount, are selected only those most frequently used. The visual signs are analyzed in detail, especially to bokuniform, flag and patterns. The conclusion is a comparison of the similarities and differences of the described symbols and signs and how these differences affect the possible future of Taekwondo.
