

Abstract (in English):

This thesis deals with a restorative justice, or the most widespread method, which represents the mediation. This method is then described in the standard form used in the Czech Republic as well as in the redesigned version adapted for violent crime in the US, which is contained in the first theoretical part. In the practical part, these two forms of mediation are compared with each other. Different moments are then reflected on three case studies, where appeared a mediation of violent juvenile crime. The results of comparison shows that the modified parameters of mediation used in case of violent crimes were not in these case studies demonstrated. This may be due to the fact that all the actions were of less violent severity, so the different elements of mediation didn't have to be necessarily exploited.
