

*The Thesis deals with the development of collective labour law in the Czech Republic from the Austro-Hungarian Empire until today. It deals with the concept of collective labour law, including its status in the legal system, with emphasis on collective labour law. The work also introduces the sources of collective labour law and comprehensively pursues the Labour Code and the law on collective bargaining. Main topic, namely the development of collective labour law in the Czech Republic is pursued in detail in the chapters concerning the development of collective labour law to give the Czech Republic, the development of collective labour law in Czechoslovakia and the current legal framework of collective labour law. A substantial part of the work deals with the process of collective bargaining, which forms an integral part of social dialogue. Collective labour disputes such as strikes and lockouts, and their solutions are described in separate chapters. Conclusion of the thesis is devoted to collective labour law in an international context.*
