

Abstract

Starting point: This thesis focuses on alcohol dependence and harmful alcohol use and their effect on person's relationship with other people.

Objective: Main objective of my work is to describe a relationship of people addicted to alcohol or people harmfully using an alcohol.

There was a domination of evasive type of relational bond in people addicted to alcohol or people harmfully using an alcohol. In the researching sample there was more frequent occurrence of anxiously evasive and evasive relational bond.

Conclusion: Based on results of this research we can say, that there is a clear link between between relational bond type and dependency behaviour of people addicted to alcohol or its harmful use.
