

Privatization of the state-owned enterprises in Bosnia and Herzegovina 1995 – 2015

Abstract

The diploma thesis „Privatization of the state-owned enterprises in Bosnia and Herzegovina 1995 - 2015“ analyses the privatization after the end of war in B&H in the context of dual transition from war to peace (postwar reconstruction) and from the centrally planned economy to liberal market. The thesis analyses the specifics of the privatization processes in B&H such as direct involvement of the international community, decentralization, ethnicization and misuse in order to reach the nationalist-motivated political goals. The thesis concludes that the privatization process was extremely influenced by the division of the society along the ethnic lines which had a significant impact on the country's economy, social conditions of the population and reintegration of the society after the war in 1992 - 1995.
