Title of the thesis:	Thermal insulation in apartment buildings: decision-making process and effect on energy savings

OVERALL ASSESSMENT (provided in English, Czech, or Slovak):

In her bachelor thesis, Lucie Častorálová aims to estimate the effect of thermal insulation of multi-family apartment buildings on energy consumption and explores the decision-making process of the associations which take the decisions about investment into the buildings. The thesis is well structured and organized, the research question interesting and important. I would like to highlight and applaud the effort to collect original data which is tailored to shed light on the clearly formulated research questions. Lucie collected two datasets – (i) a questionnaire survey among associations of unit owners designed to understand the decision-making process, and (ii) an online/face-to-face survey with heads of the associations conducted in order to collect detailed data about energy consumption over time. The data analysis relies on appropriate econometric methods. To summarize, I am happy to recommend the thesis for the defence and suggest grade A.

A potential question for the defense of the thesis might be the following: You mentioned that when using an online approach to collect the data about energy consumption, the response rate was very low. What was the response rate for the first data set? The data consists of 74 respondents. To how many email addresses was the questionnaire sent?
