Abstract (in English):

I would like to map out a network of mills and their owners in the Neveklovs and Sedlčany's area, which was at the time of the Protectorate of Bohemia and Moravia called displaced territory. First part is about mill trade progress followed mills and millers stories (focused on the first half of the 20th century).

Mill trade belongs among important and remarkable part of Czech national history. Totally different mills were produced in Benešov and Neveklov and Sedlčany area which were an inportant part of agro culture and interesting part of landscape. Establishment of the SS military training area meaned tragic time for mills progress. Farmers and millers had a short time to leave their farms and mills. They tried to survive in the very hard time of Germany occupation. All of this will be included in the context of the time and characters.
