OVERALL ASSESSMENT (provided in English, Czech, or Slovak):

The thesis examines to what extent consumer price shocks originating in the euro area affect the Czech prices. The author constructs block restriction vector autoregression model consisting from two block – the euro area and Czech block. The restriction in the vector autoregression model is set in the way that the Czech block of variables cannot affect the euro area ones, but not vice versa. The results suggest that the prices in the euro area are one of major drivers of Czech prices.

I find the thesis to be well-written and logically structured. The author cites appropriate literature, in fact, Vladimir shows great knowledge of existing related literature. The vector autoregression models is presented coherently and it is easy to follow the reasoning of the author. There is very comprehensive evaluation of the stability of the results. All important econometric tests are carried out. Overall, Vladimir has shown that he is able to work on large empirical project independently. There are some typos but not many.

Overall, it is an excellent thesis with explicit value added and well-executed applied econometric work. Therefore, I recommend the grade "výborně" (A).
