The bachelor thesis aims to analyse the views of the British Conservative Party regarding its position on the European Union in the time span from the election of the new Conservative Party leader in 2005 to the official presentation of the party Manifesto on the occasion of the extraordinary parliamentary elections 2017. The thesis gradually maps the election of the party leaders in 2005 and 2016, discussions in the Party, and topics in which the party in the election 2010, 2015 and 2017 campaigns. The thesis uses the analysis of program statements, public speeches, interviews and news articles. Due to the policy of the British Conservative Party, as one of the two historically most important political parties in the United Kingdom, being connected with the country's current political situation, the thesis also analyses the party split on the UK's position regarding the Brexit.
