

Protocol of the defense of the doctoral dissertation thesis

Doc. JUDr. Jan Ondřej, CSc., DSc., the Head of the Commission, welcomed the present members of the commission and introduced the doctoral student. He informed that all the conditions for the holding of oral defense, including publishing of Ján Králik's thesis, were satisfied. Then, the doctoral student gave the opening remarks and presented his work. PhD student described the content and concept of his thesis. In addition, He mentioned the goals and the significance of the study. He clarified theoretical and practical significance of the research, method and outline and literature review. He discussed methodology, structure and benefit of his thesis.

The first opponent, doc. Hýbnerová, recommended the dissertation thesis for the defense. The thesis may be evaluated as complex and well argued. It shows a very good insight of the author in the topic and brings new research outcomes as is required by this type of qualification thesis. Opponent posed her questions for discussion during the defense of the thesis set forth in her report.

The second opponent, Faix, evaluated the manuscript positively. Despite certain flaws, he commend author's efforts and consider the submitted thesis as a piece of academic work, which meets the general requirements for this type of thesis, as required by the relevant provisions of the Charles University in Prague and its Faculty of Law. He added that he would like to hear the answer to the questions posed in his opponent opinion.

Ján Králik thanked for the questions and the remarks of both opponents and responded to their enquiries.

Doc. Ondřej, the Head of the Commission, opened a general debate and gave the floor to prof. Šturma. The supervisor mentioned the collaboration with PhD student. He recommend the Ph.D. thesis of Mgr. Ján Králik, LL.M. titled Sexual Exploitation and Abuse by UN Peacekeepers for acceptance. Then Králik Jan thanked Members of the Commission for their participation.

After termination of the general debate, the public was excluded and the secret voting concerning the awarding of the Ph.D. title took place. The result of the voting was 5 to 0 votes (5 votes were positive, 0 vote was negative).
