

Abstract

Title of the thesis

A comparison of the scope of climbing courses in the Army of the Czech and Slovak Republic.

Target of the thesis

A target of this paper is to find out and compare on the basis of gathered data whether there are any scope differences between the military climbing courses of the Army of the Czech and Slovak Republic.

Method

This thesis has been elaborated in the form of a pilot study. The study was conducted in coordination with senior instructors of military climbing both in the Czech and Slovak Republic. Relevant data were firstly collected, then analyzed and finally compared.

Findings

Having compared the data of the scopes of courses, this paper shows that they differ from each other in their structures, which is largely caused by different conditions created for the instruction of climbing. Individual dissimilarities regarding the compared scopes of courses are described in the thesis in detail.
