

Abstract

The presented diploma thesis focuses on the study and analysis of the Czech Republic's unemployment. Unemployment as a social phenomenon in Czech society emerges once again after year 1990 in context with extensive political and economic changes. Apart from introduction to data collection related to unemployment in the Czech Republic, the aim of this thesis is to describe the development in area of unemployment policy, taking the entry of the Czech Republic to European Union into account. Furthermore, this thesis analyzes the unemployment in relation to selected socio-demographic characteristics and evaluates the level of employment and unemployment in relation to other European Union countries. The thesis also includes the construction of models using the logistic regression, with unemployment rate acting as dependent variable and age, sex and education as the effect variables.
