

Abstract

The thesis focuses on comparing of development of internal migration population development in regions of Saxony and Ústecký region. The first part of this thesis devotes to historical, population and migration development in Germany (with a view to former German Democratic Republic) and then to Saxony in the second half of 20th century. Then thesis observes natural reproduction and migration trends in the Czech republic and Ústecký region. Evaluation of demographic processes focused also on economic indicators of internal migration – unemployment and housing.
