

Abstract

Title: Readiness of citizens to effectively resolve emergency situations, when support of civilization background is unavailable.

Objectives: Objective of this bachelor's thesis is to observe readiness of subjects during situations in which they're forced by circumstances to stay outdoors. The results are compared between scouts and other citizens. Experience is analyzed based on a series of questions aimed at survival skills in harsh or challenging environments outdoors.

Methods: The data was obtained through a questionnaire method. Target audience were people older than 15 years. Questionnaire was distributed only through the internet.

Results: There were 676 respondents total in this research, out of which 200 were used for the data. Obtained information was processed into tables and graphs. Evaluation suggests better readiness of members of the scout organization for survival in natural environments as opposed to other citizens of Czech Republic.
