Contribution

The main value added of the thesis of Kateřina Kinzlová is to provide (a bit of back-of-the-envelope) estimates of the incidence of teacher attrition in the Czech Republic. While important for policy makers, data on teacher attrition are not recorded in the Czech Republic and till 2016 there was also no data on the number of entrants to the teaching profession.

The first part of the thesis provides large number of statistics documenting teacher remuneration, number of teachers, teacher-to-student ratios and other. These statistics are very important to illustrate the state of teacher profession, but their presentation is just a repetition of (and in some cases update to) recent studies by Daniel Múnich.

Methods

Kateřina departs from available statistics on the number of teachers in primary and secondary education and their age distribution to retrieve the number of teachers in each age group and school level. She next makes a set of assumptions allowing her to use these numbers to estimate the rate of attrition (dropout rate) of teachers. She provides two sets of estimates – one is based on the assumption that the age structure of entrants to the teaching profession was constant over the last 10 years – the other based on the assumption that the ratio of entrants to the number of teachers is constant. Both approaches lead to estimating very high levels of teacher attrition.

These are simple back-of-the-envelope or accounting exercises, but they provide useful information.

Literature

A decent, although not fully complete, literature review is provided in the thesis.

Manuscript form

The manuscript is written in a decent English with minor issues. Presentation is clear and tables in the empirical part are helping the reader to understand calculations. The thesis would benefit from a clearer flow of thoughts, though. While the first part of the thesis puts forward the issue of teacher remuneration, the main contribution of the thesis is estimation of teacher dropout rates.

Summary and suggested questions for the discussion during the defense

The thesis by Kateřina Kinzlová touches a very important topic of the attractiveness of teacher profession. The student got very involved in the topic and she collected a lot of information and data relevant to this issue. However, while working on the thesis Kateřina found it hard to choose which information is relevant and what should be the main focus of the thesis. The final version of the thesis was prepared in some rush, but nevertheless it conveys a clear and important message – teachers in the Czech Republic often get discouraged from performing the profession!

Suggested question: What data should be collected to allow proper analysis of the status of teaching profession? Why?
