This bachelor thesis deals with Black Panther Party, one of the most distinctive organizations connected with militant aspects in field of emancipation of black inhabitants in the USA. Black Panther Party was operating in the U. S. from the half of 1960s till beginning of 1980s. The author defines the party and its priorities in the fight, that it led against repressions made by the society, government and police on Afro-Americans. Circumstances of party foundation are explained, its most important members are introduced. In the text, there is also clarified the issue connected to armament of Afroamericans, which had been loudly supported by the party, and it was one of its main values. Significant part of the thesis is characteristic of community programs made by the party, that were targeting problematic areas of life of black inhabitants, but also contained an agenda of party politics spreading especially among young people.
