Abstract (in English):

Archeological exclavations on plots no. 72.74 in Nymburk present basis for wider study of functional disposition of urban plot and town as a whole. Then, there is a question of material culture of high medieval and early modern household in Nymburk. History, appearance and development of town of Nymburk is studied and described and earlier field and academic research is summarized.
