

## **Abstract**

This bachelor thesis deals with the inner system of a library as designed by Gabriel Naudé in his 1627 work *Advis pour dresser une bibliothèque*. The system designed by Naudé is being compared to other systems used in the European libraries and described in the literature of the 16<sup>th</sup> and the 17<sup>th</sup> century. The thesis then provides a description of the libraries where Naudé worked and analyzes the application of the library organization system designed by Naudé in those libraries. The last part of the thesis deals with the Naudé's work in the context of the contemporary philosophical movements and it presents the movement of "libertinage érudit" which Naudé was a part of.
