

Abstract

This bachelor thesis deals with the description of phonetics and phonology of present condition of Czech in Husinec, Strzelin district. Its focal point is an analysis of phonetic and phonological varieties found in records based on field research in the town of Gościęcice Dolne, Strzelin district, Poland. The next parts of the thesis are following: summary of Husinec's history, current condition of Husinec and description of linguistic research in the area up to now in the field of Czech dialectology. The practical part of the thesis also includes the research methodology, description of working with the material and metadata about the informant. There is a comparison of own consequences and consequences in the mentioned literature below the analysis.
