

Abstract

This bachelor thesis deals with auxiliary verbs in contemporary Italian and German languages. It is divided into two parts, the theoretical and practical one. The first chapter of the theoretical part discusses the definition of auxiliary verbs and inquires into the auxiliaries and their choice in various languages. The second chapter treats the auxiliary verbs and their use in Italian, the emphasis is put on the choice of auxiliary verbs. The third chapter focuses on auxiliaries in German. The attention is again aimed especially to the choice of the auxiliary verbs. The fourth chapter brings a comparison between the auxiliaries and their use in both languages. In the practical part there is an analysis of corpus research focused on chosen verbs with auxiliary split. The source of the data for the practical part are the *Araneum Italicum Maius* and *Araneum Germanicum Maius* corpora.
