The present thesis deals with the evaluation of development of contemporary Israeli novel, by comparing oftwo Yehudit Katzir's novels, Le-Matissejesh et ha-shemesh ba-beten (Matisse Has the Sun in His Bel/y, 1995) and Hine ani matchila (Here I begin/ Dearest Anne, 2003). The distinction between several periods in modem Hebrew literature is suggested, with regard to the thematic and conceptional development of contemporary Israeli novel during the last three decades and the Israeli novel presented by women fiction. The basic biographical data about Yehudit Katzir, the compendium ofher writing, and a summary ofthree ofher books, subjected to analysis in the following chapters - a collection ofnovellas Sogrim et hayam (Closing the Sea, 1990), and two aforementioned novel s - are submitted. Particular attention is given to the reflection of these books by current Israeli critique.
