

Population structures of Koloveč, 1910–1921

Abstract

This thesis deals with the Demographic development of the town Koloveč during World War I., which significantly affected the structure of the Population not only in the Czech lands, but also in Europe. The first part deals with the World War I., its origin and consequences that influenced the structure of the population even after the war. Another important event in 1918 was the Spanish flu, which caused the deaths of several tens of millions of people in Europe. The main part of the thesis is devoted to the number of births and deaths of the population and the number of marriages in Koloveč in 1910–1921 based on data from the Koloveč registry. It also includes a comparison between 1910 and 1921 when a census was carried out in the Czech lands. Data are analysed according to preselected criteria in Koloveč. These gauges are divided into four parts, namely Demographic features, ethnic and socio-cultural characteristic and socio-professional characteristics.
