Abstract

This diploma thesis deals with theme of sexual assistance to people with disabilities. Its aim

how social workers and social service workers looks at sexuality their clients and use of

sexual assistance within residential social services. The research was based on semi-structed

interviews. Obtained data are dividet into four categories – access to client sexuality, the way

of meeting clients sexual needs, viewing at sexual assistance service, the way organizations

participate in providing sexual assistance.

The research results show that in most of organizations sexuality belongs among the areas of

work with their clients. Some organizations perceived certain obstacles that prevent them

from effectively opening or developing the topic of sexuality. In differece experience of

organizations that work with sexuality in the form intimate assistance bring positive results

and have good assumption for the introduction of active sexual assistance.
