

Abstract

This bachelor thesis is focused on the issue of girls' gangs in the Czech Republic. Its first aim is to divide the respondents into two groups: group of gang members and group of nongang members. Data for this division are data collected within the ISRD3 project. After that the thesis will aim to figure out these groups differ in individual characteristics and social environment characteristics in which the groups exist. Analysis will be based on risk factors discussed in theories of crime.
