## **Abstract**

The bachelor's thesis deals with the possibility of prevention of diseases of civilization from the point of view of nutrition; mainly the relationship between the quality of food consumed and these diseases. The theoretical part briefly describes selected diseases and risk factors involved in their origin, prevention, nutrition as one of the main determinants of health, ultra processed foods and their impact on health.
