Evaluation

Major criteria:

Author has chosen a very current topic for the thesis. Author concentrated on case law of the European Court of Human Rights regarding the framing and interpretation of the scope of Article 14 of the European Convention on Human Rights. Author examined a distinction between anti-discriminatory provisions of article 14 of the European Convention on Human Rights and article 1 of the Protocol No. 12 to the European Convention on Human Rights and their application by the European Court of Human Rights. Author defined and clearly explained legal basis of the concept of discrimination.

In the second part the author analyzed relevant case law of the European Court of Human Rights regarding chosen member states of the Council of Europe.
