

The work engages in the status of the Czech language in the Polish School in Prague.

In the first part, the author deals with the history and formation of Polish schools abroad, as well as with the formation, development, and current situation of the Polish School in Prague.

The second part characterises the subject of the Czech language in the Polish School based on program documents and teaching plans.

The last chapter is based on a questionnaire survey, by which the author ascertained the knowledge of pupils of the Polish School in Prague, their attitudes to Czech, the way they use the Czech language, and their experience with the tuition as well as their evaluation.

The conclusion formulates certain recommendations for teaching Czech based on the ascertained facts.
