

## **Abstract**

The thesis analyses selected characteristics of the interaction of grandparents and grandchildren in shared activities. It focuses on the importance of shared activities for grandparents and children. Specifically, it examines what taking part in shared activities brings to children and adults, considering their relationship and the content of these activities.
