

Within my bachelor's thesis I concern myself with the analysis of transgressives and nonattributive participles. In the theory section I indicate their key attributes, from which follow the common features between the individual forms, which form the basis of my initial thesis. In the methodology section I describe the means and methods used during the individual analyses. In the first analysis I try to find out in a contrastive way, if there is a one hundred percent overlap between specific transgressive forms and specific participle forms and in case there is not I try to establish the possible reasons for an overlap between transgressives and the other forms. Moreover I try to figure out, being inspired by the model from Emil Dvořák, whether there is a visible decline in use of the transgressives, whose number I calculate by means of the second analysis. After the analysis section I evaluate the findings made within the both analyses and describe what it implies. In the end I summarize the results and bring my thesis to a close.
