Abstract

This thesis is dealing with translation of two selected chapters from *On Writing and Worldbuilding: Volume I* (2019) and a commentary of said translation. The book was written by Timothy Hickson. The former chapter is dedicated to foreshadowing and its subtypes, and its uses whereas the latter discuses polytheistic religions, its creation, and general rules.
