Contribution

The thesis is a remarkable and original contribution to the economic history of Czechoslovak Filmmaking. There is no similar study that would deal with the question of profitability of the Czechoslovak New Wave. For the first time, this thesis shows that despite its significant place in the history of filmmaking, the Czechoslovak New Wave was not successful from an economic perspective. To reach the aims of his thesis, Vojtěch had to undergo a long period of searching and collecting data for his analysis incl. time-consuming archival research.

Methods

Vojtěch combined historical and economic research methods: archival research, descriptive analysis, comparative analysis, and regression analysis. First of all, I would like to emphasise that Vojtěch had no relevant data for his study at the beginning of his writing. Thus, the first step of his research was archival research. He collected data and created a database that helped him provide, for instance, a first overview of the economic performance of the film industry in Czechoslovakia in the 1960s. To demonstrate his findings, he used statistical tests and box plots. To test the hypothesis about the profitability of the Czechoslovak New Wave, he used regression models with the following variables: production days, atelier days and exterior days.

Literature

The list of literature demonstrates student awareness that the Czechoslovak New Wave was a cultural achievement. However, I would suggest employing more titles from the foreign literature focused on the economic history of the film industry.

Manuscript form

No remarks.

Summary and suggested questions for the discussion during the defense I recommend the thesis for defense and suggest a grade of A. In my view, the thesis not only fulfills the requirements for a bachelor thesis at IES, Faculty of Social Sciences, Charles University but also demonstrates student's courage to explore yet non-researched issues in economic history. The results of the Urkund analysis do not indicate text similarity with other available sources.
