

ABSTRACT

The thesis is focused on the portfolio as a didactic tool in the teaching of the art education at the first stage of the primary school.

The theoretical part of the thesis describes the portfolio and its various types. It focuses on the student's work portfolio, the electronic portfolio and the professional portfolio as a tool for the development of the self-reflective and the self-assessment competencies of pupils and teachers.

It is also devoted to the assessment with focusing on the formative evaluation in the teaching. The last chapter is devoted to art education and the evaluation of the art education through the portfolio.

The practical part is built on the portfolios of the pupils' works, on the electronic portfolio and the professional portfolio through the implementation of the art project which is called "Trees and Leaves". The aim of the practical part was the creation of individual portfolios, which were created in the specific year of the primary school. The implemented portfolios should be contributed to the development of self-reflective and self-assessment competencies in pupils. The portfolios were created during the first half of the school year. In this time section was also planned and realized the art project which the topic was "Trees and Leaves". The individual lessons of the art education and the work with the portfolios of the pupils were reflected with the help of the ALACT method.

The portfolios did not contribute to the development of self-reflective and self-assessment competencies of the pupils. It also noticed a shift in the pupils' artistic creation, the technical skills and the artistic thinking. The portfolios also allow the teacher to better evaluate the student's work as the teacher can focus on the process of the student's creation and not only on the final work. The course itself of the artistic activity's realization is often more significant than the result.
