The thesis deals with antique-style buildings which have arisen within the garden architecture in Bohemia and Moravia at the time of neo-classicism. The buildings in this thesis not only have ancient elements, but also some constructive form drawing from antiquity was used in their construction. These antique-style buildings started to appear in Czech countries especially in the last quarter of the 18th century, and their popularity lasts out nearly till the half of the 19th century.

At first the thesis describes classicism architecture and its main elements. Further it deals with the design of the gardens and parks in their era and finally it deals with their antique models. The part, in which the work deals with particular places – gardens and parks situated in our territory and of course buildings themselves, follows. Description, inspiration and evaluation of buildings are attached. In conclusion catalogue of these selected antique-style buildings is worked up
