**ABSTRACT** 

Title:

Relationship between quality of serving and the defensive phase at net in men Volleyball

at the Olympic Games 2008 in Beijing.

**Objective:** 

The purpose of this thesis was to find out relationship between quality of serving and

the defensive phase at net in elite volleyball teams. The thesis should also give a more

detailed view on progress of this relationship in time, and to show what is the character of

the relationship in best teams.

**Methods:** 

The main method used in this work was, standardized indirect observation. We

observed matches on Olympic volleyball tournament 2008, in Beijing, where we assessed

the selected playing activities on 5-degree scale. After that, we applied one-dimensional

methods of statistical analysis to find out statistical significance (chi-square test) and

methods of objectively-logical analysis.

**Results:** 

The results refer to significant relationship between quality of serving and the

defensive phase at net. This relationship appears to be stable in time, independent on

changes made in volleyball (rally point system, libero specialization). By comparing of

this relationship in best teams we did not find statistically significant differences, but we

consider as a big advantage for team to be able to group a two-person block after poor

quality service.
