**OVERALL ASSESSMENT** (provided in English, Czech, or Slovak):

In the thesis, Hana deals with a very topical issue of obesity and diabetes assuming that soft drinks play a significant role. It is thus important to learn more about consumer behavior to be able to avert negative consequences of obesity and diabetes. Having introduced work that has been published on analyzing consumer behavior, Hana goes on to describe methodology used in the thesis in a considerable detail, which is followed by her own independent analysis. In the empirical section of the thesis, she first estimates own-price elasticity of demand for soft drinks and then simulates impacts of different VAT rates on demand. Besides, she evaluates the effect for different income groups separately.

Hana's thesis is a nice example of an independent work of a high quality. It was a pleasure to be her supervisor – the cooperation was very enriching and productive for me as well. Hana showed deep understanding of the methodology used and a great passion for the topic. The results of her thesis could have great political impacts. Not only do the results confirm findings from abroad as to income elasticity, but simulations of an effect of a potential cost increase resulting from a tax on soft drinks are likely to save healthcare costs because adverse effect of soft drinks on human's health has been proved. The thesis should definitely be rewritten into at least a working paper.

There are some typos in the thesis, sometimes language could be improved and the introduction deserves a little restructuring. Aside of that, I do not have any major comments regarding the thesis since Hana incorporated everything that we agreed on.

Given the qualities of the thesis, I suggest that Hana be awarded **grade 1** (excellent). I also recommend the thesis for Dean's Award.
