Teacher's views in accommodating for the learning style of students' with dyslexia in Czech language classes

The title of the study seems to be carefully chosen and closely relevant to Minura's professional practice. It is a pity that the abstract rather disvalues overall report. The abstract only indicates what a reader can expect from the report. It provides only a taste of the story; not brief answers to what, why, how and results. A reader is provided with an opportunity to learn what he/she is able to. (iv). Similarly, wordings such as one can this or that. Seems to be other overused in the report. Nevertheless the report is very well organized into simple and consistent system of headings and subheadings, and of spacing between sections.

Literature review is very well structured. I appreciate that Munira often presents controversial theories together with her own critical comments. Overview of the relevant research findings and theories is rich. However, it is not always easy for a reader to find direct links between the topic of the study and some statements (eg. p. 21 students' voice). The methodology chapter gives information about the kinds of data obtained, why and how. Research paradigms is critically discussed.

Information about ethical issues raised by the study and the procedures followed to address them during the study is provided. Very well organized and structured questioners, interviews and observations have been employed. I did not find explanation of using different colors used Appendix 3 (b). Please explain it during the viva.

The data chapter is usefully organized into subchapters to cover different aspects of the study. In the evaluation chapter better attention should have been paid to what you have found link to previous knowledge as discussed in the literature review. Example of such links can be presented in the viva.

Recommendations on p. 91 give useful and concrete questions for further research same for educational practice.

During the viva I also recommend to present how lessons learned from the conduct of the study will (or will not be) used in Oman and/or what seems to be useful for future contribution in the field.

Extensive research findings and literature has been used in the report.

Overall, very good report!

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
