

The bachelor's thesis deals with the first aid knowledge of parents of preschool children with life-threatening conditions.

The theoretical part introduces the concept of first aid, pre-school age and defines its anatomical, physiological and psychomotor differences associated with the development of life-threatening conditions in children at this age. It focuses on the symptoms, course and general first aid in life-threatening conditions and selected the most frequent accident and nonaccident states occurring in this age group.

The point of the thesis is the empirical part, which is compiled on the basis of quantitative research survey compiled by the method of questionnaire survey. Research sample consists of nonspecialists, parents of preschool children from Hradec Kralove region. The aim of the research survey is to explore the knowledge of parents of preschool children on first aid, their interest in the first aid and willingness in this issue to further training.
