COMMENTARY:

Main goal of reviewed thesis is understanding the possible dynamics behind the failures of the post-conflict governments with the aim of indicating possible policy implications for future governments by examining the political and societal framework their predecessors operated in. Firstly the thesis successfully analyzes causes of weak Lebanese governments in post-conflict society and political systém (in this way Lebanon has become the model case of so called collapsed state during past few decades).

Generally the author reached all declared objectives. Submited paper meets all formal criteria (length, structure, methodology, sources etc.) and standards required for IEPS' master thesis. V.
