

Submitted bachelor's thesis concentrates on the research of selected elements of the historical thought of significant Czech historian Jaroslav Goll (1846-1929). It offers detailed analysis of his methodological viewpoints and representative enclaves of thought which became characteristic for formation of his role in contemporary historiographical discursus. The educt of this thesis is an evaluation of importance of Goll's activity and finding of imaginary key to an adequate understanding of his work.
