

This work discusses action of armies of German allies, i.e. Romanians, Italians and Hungarians, in the battle of Stalingrad. It is conceived so that to catch the development of events from the beginning of involvement of Romania, Italy and Hungary on the eastern front to the destruction of their armies during the mentioned battle.
