

Method of pediatric neurologist Professor Tardieu focuses on patients with cerebral palsy. Its basis is a 26-point factor rating, which is carefully evaluated by a psychologist. According to the results of subsequent therapy is provided with short and long term rehabilitation plan. This topic is examined in great detail in the first theoretical part. The second part deals with the practical evaluation the Tardieu's scale, which is used to measure spasticity in patients with lesions of the central motoneuron expression of various etiologies.
