Unstoppable headway of human kind had to face prejudices and control of those in power for centuries. Renaissance brought massive progress of civic society. Not only Church and monasteries were wisdom-holders any more. In that respect England was the first to leave old ways of thinking behind (as many times after) and overtook the rest of Europe.
