

Abstract

The Fairy Tale Test (FTT) is a projective personality test designed for children aged 6 to 12 years. FTT is based on the association between fairy tales and unconscious processes. Its goal is to assess the child's personality profile and to offer information not only about single personality traits but also their interrelations. It is possible it effectively employed as a method to assess eventual personality changes over time or as a tool in clinical or cross-cultural research as well. The Fairy Tale Test was standardized in five countries of the world – Greece, Russia, China, India and Turkey, at the present time we effort to set up standard specification also in the Czech Republic. This rigorous paper should also contribute to the standardization with administrating FTT and its evaluation to the selected sample of six to eight-year-old children.
