

Abstract

Title: Speed Skating arena and public attitude to its construction

Objectives: The main aim of the diploma thesis is the analysis of a project of a speed-skating rink in Velky Osek. Citizens from Kolin and Nymburk regions, as well as Prague, have been polled on the possible rink construction. Citizens have been surveyed on their foreknowledge and the future possibility of the of grounds usage.

Methods: A descriptive analysis was used to comment on data gathered in relationship to the proposed construction of a speed-skating rink. Furthermore, a SWOT analysis was used in order to evaluate the direct external and internal impact the proposed construction of a speed-skating rink in Velky Osek (Kolin region). A quantitative survey (questionnaire) has been used in polling citizens on their attitude toward the possible construction of the rink.

Results: The results have shown the heterogeneity of the attitudes of the citizens. However, we may conclude that there are more people who support the idea of constructing a speed-skating rink in the Czech Republic, rather than the proposed construction project in Velky Osek.
