Title of the thesis:	The Determinants of central banking transparency: An Empirical Analysis

OVERALL ASSESSMENT (provided in English, Czech, or Slovak):

Tomáš examines the determinants of central bank transparency, both for the area of monetary policy as well as of financial stability, making use of the indexes developed in Horvath and Vasko (2012). In comparison to this study, Tomáš examines the determinants in a greater detail and specifically investigates the driving factors of various sub-components of indexes. In addition, Tomáš examines a wider set of possible determinants of central bank transparency.

Tomáš finds that more developed countries with flexible exchange rate regimes exhibit greater transparency of their central banks. Also better governance increases transparency. I would be happy to see more on how the institutional structure of financial markets supervision interacts with transparency.

The thesis contains an excellent literature survey and econometrics is carried out competently. The thesis reads very well and provides an interesting extension of previous research.

I suggest the grade A for Tomáš.

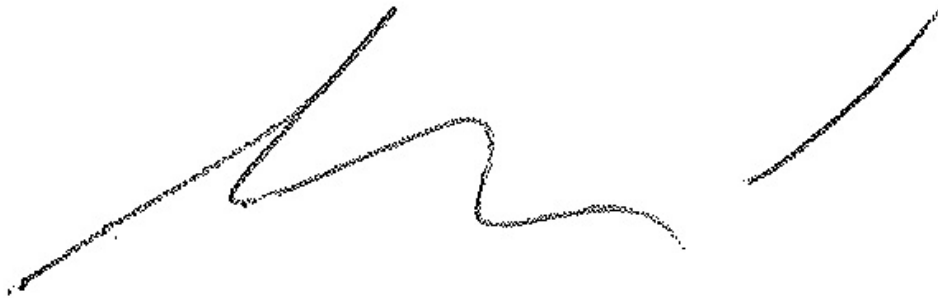
