## **Content of the Report:**

The dissertation thesis by Tomáš Havránek is of outstanding quality. All three opponents, including myself, have come to the same conclusion in their assessment prior to the predefense. For a more detailed discussion and appreciation of the thesis, I refer to my earlier pre-defense report from April 4, 2013. I would simply like to point out two aspects here:

First, the fact that the major chapters of this thesis have been published in very good, peer-reviewed academic journals shows that Mr. Havránek is already a well-respected member of the academic community. He has earned his reputation through his specialization on meta-analysis in the context of international trade, thus bringing an innovative method into an old economic field and scrutinizing previous findings in the literature. He has shown very convincingly that existing research results have to be re-thought and refined our knowledge about the trade effects of currency unions and the spillover effects from FDI. In both cases, his findings point towards more differentiated picture and lead directly into very relevant

policy conclusions. Thus, I would like to emphasis in this final report again Tomáš's ability to combine state-of-the-art methods with highly policy relevant questions and his success in deriving clear conclusions.

Second, I would like to stress that Tomáš responded very satisfactorily to the (few) comments that were raised by all three opponents. In doing so, he showed his ability to argue convincingly based on a sound knowledge of economics, economic policy and econometric methods.

Overall, I strongly recommend this thesis to be defended without any changes! I wish Tomáš all the best for his future career, which I am sure will be a bright one and one that is rewarding for our community!
