### **OVERALL ASSESSMENT** (provided in English, Czech, or Slovak):

Dominika analyzes the determinants of monetary policy transparency around the world. She makes use of the monetary policy transparency index developed by Horvath and Vasko (2012). Her results nicely update the previous NBER WP study by Eichengreen and Dincer (2009) and extend it in several ways. Several panel regression models are used to assess the determinants of monetary policy transparency.

The results are quite sensible. Political and institutional variables, and monetary policy regimes influences significantly the extent of transparency.

The thesis reads very well and Dominika shows excellent understanding of current transparency literature. Econometrics is carried out competently. In my view, Dominika put extensive effort in the thesis (the data collection on the explanatory variables of monetary policy transparency was time consuming) and her thesis is exceptional. In fact, this BA thesis looks more like MA thesis.

I suggest the grade A for Dominika and proposing this thesis for Dean Award is a must.

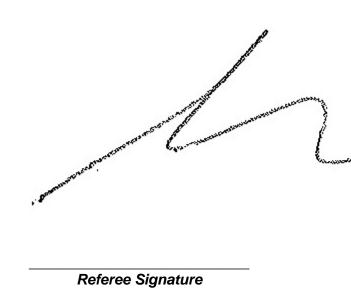
