In hindi tenses and moods can be divided into two groups: root tenses and moods and auxiliated tenses and moods. Among root tenses and moods belong: futurum, imperative and subjunctive. Auxiliated tenses and moods can be divided into: imperfective, perfective and progressive.

This work describes each of moods and tenses in mentioned groups. Each is written according to structure and function. The decription is accompanied by examples from descriptive grammars of Hindi and literature.
