OVERALL ASSESSMENT (provided in English, Czech, or Slovak):

Author describes current economic development in Russia since the 90ies. In the 1st chapter is the description of the financial crisis in 1998, how it was experienced in Russia. Author explains, that the era of President Putin was a logical consequence of the crisis and describes a package of reformes known as Gref´s program. In the 6th chapter, complicated links between government and business are discribed and again, facts are presented in such a way that the logics of events can be understood. The same could be judged on the chapters on investment climate and oil dependency of Russian economy.

Part of this thesis is quantitative analysis. The author presents three models. I am not an econometrician but in my opinion, models are relevant for showing the specifics of economic growth in Russia, importance of exports and production in the primary sector – especially mining.

I think this thesis is well balanced and is interesting for anyone interested in current Russian development. Value added is that the author was able to filter the immense material on Russian economic development and made a readable synthesis. For me, it was very interesting to read the last chapter with the prospects for the future – author is native Russian so her opinions are opinions of an insider, even when she cites some generally accepted opinion.

I believe that this thesis fulfills the standards for an IES master thesis and I recommend this thesis for defence.
